- Award of Full Tuition and Fees, renewable on an annual basis through 8th grade, assuming satisfactory academic performance, conduct, and demonstrated qualities of character

Scholarship Application Process

- Schedule a private tour of the school with Admissions Director: Lesley Brice, 318.213.6344 or LBrice@southfield-school.org
- Complete the online Southfield application and submit with the non-refundable \$50 application fee
- Submit all prior academic records and standardized test results
- Complete and submit the Scholarship Application Form including “All About Me” essay – **DUE BY March 1, 2023**
- The Teacher Recommendation Form (included in online application for admission) must be completed and submitted to Southfield by one of the student’s current teachers
- Applicant will spend a full visit day on campus participating in the classroom and getting to know students and faculty
- Applicant will interview with the Scholarship Committee on the visit day
- Applicant will take the Admission Exam on the visit day

Application Review Process

- All applicants must first be approved for admission to Southfield School
- Once approved for admission, the Scholarship Committee will review the scholarship application
- The Scholarship Committee consists of the Head of School, Division Director, Admissions Director, and one faculty member
- All scholarship applicants will be notified of decision by April 6, 2023
