- Available to one new 6th, 7th, or 8th grade student in the 2025-26 school year who demonstrates financial need
- Awarded on a competitive basis with factors including the following:
 - Most recent semester and current report card
 - GPA of 3.5 or higher
 - 2024 Standardized Test Scores
 - 2024 LEAP Scores at the Mastery or Advanced Level in ELA and Math
 - OR
 - Other standardized test with nationally normed percentiles at 75th or above in ELA and Math
 - Attendance and Discipline record
- Award of Full Tuition and Academic Fees, renewable on an annual basis through 8th grade, assuming exemplary academic performance, conduct, attendance and demonstrated qualities of character

- Spend a full visit day on campus attending classes, interviewing with the Scholarship Committee and completing an admissions exam
